- the Euro-Mediterranean intergovernmental institution of 43 countries, 28 EU member states + 15 Southern and Eastern Mediterranean countries




#### **UfM Mission**

- 60 Diplomats, financial experts and project managers from more than 20 countries and institutions



  - Sustainable Consumption and Production (Pollution Prevention)
  - Climate Change

+ ecosystem protection, integrated maritime policy/blue economy, ICZM, education sustainable development

- 2018 and beyond:
  - Potential 2<sup>nd</sup> UfM Ministerial Declaration on ENV and CC in 2020
  - Towards the reinforcement of the Circular, Inclusive, Low-Zero Carbon Economy package, with a focus on pollution prevention/Sustainable Consumption and Production; Landscape Restoration/Drought/Desertification/Forestry
  - Close link to the Rio Conventions; UfMS Observer at UNFCCC (UN Climate Change), CBD (Convention on Biological Diversity) and UNCCD (UN Convention on Desertification)



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## Why here today

FAO promoted, IKI funded and UfM labelled project
"Scaling up forest and landscape restoration
in order to restore biodiversity and promote joint mitigation and
adaptation approaches in the Mediterranean"

- The project addresses directly the Rio Conventions
- the Bonn Challenge on forest landscape restoration
- the Paris Agreement on Climate Change;
- Aichi Targets of the Convention on Biological Diversity
- · The project as labelled falls directly into the wider UfM regional agenda;
- The project operates at both regional level and national level; its potential upscale to other countries willing to join, is already embedded in the project structure
- The project foresees the involvement of multiple partners in the region
- This work falls within the wider UfMS-FAO-UNCCD partnership on drought/desertification
- Consultation and ongoing preparatory work for the next **UfM Ministerial Declaration on ENV** and **CC**, tentatively scheduled for **2020**; Since 2014 we have a switch towards a more integrated approach soil land air, associated to circular economy, SCP and green entrepreneurship

Compact assessment of where the SEMed countries stand with the NDCs (and whenever available NAPs) implementation process.


Identification of common goals that could lead to joint approaches on the regional or sub-regional level (public policies, technical assistance, investment projects)

Analysis of the benefits of collective/joint approaches

Through a review of all official NDCs submitted to the UNFCCC, as well as all NAPs and National Communications

In Adaptation, Forestry is one of the relevant NDC sectors.

Measures grouping	Countries
Afforestation and reforestation, and biosphere conservation	Albania, Algeria, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, Palestine, Tunisia, Turkey
Support to national, regional or local policy, through technical assistance or policy lending	Morocco, Turkey

#### **Examples of measures relevant for at least 4 countries:**

- Increase/Introduce Afforestation projects
- Increase/introduce Reforestation projects
- Promote and increase the practice sustainable forest management
- Biosphere conservation projects (including payments for ecosystem services) targeting reducing emissions from deforestation or degradation of ecosystems



# Forestry – Prioritized adaptation measures

#### **Measures Forestry**

Reforestation, aiming at increasing the share of high natural forests

Natural regeneration as the basis for forest growth, adequate support through afforestation (using indigenous tree types) if the natural process of forest regeneration fails

Silvicultural improvement of low forests and shrubs, mainly in small private holdings, for bio-energy production and carbon storage

Rehabilitation of forest nurseries and the expansion of indigenous and multi-use species,

Preservation of the forest (e.g. from deforestation, erosion, etc.) particularly through the protection of key habitats and varieties, and of trees, plants and animals.

Development of fire-protection measures, with an emphasis on prevention and fast response in the case of fire.

Re-establishment of forest order after harvesting; adequate and timely rehabilitation of surfaces damaged by fire

Currently only Lebanon, Morocco and Tunisia are prioritizing forestry for adaptation in their NDCs

Soft measures such as Policy and Regulation, Education or Monitoring and Evaluation is currently only prioritized by Lebanon.


